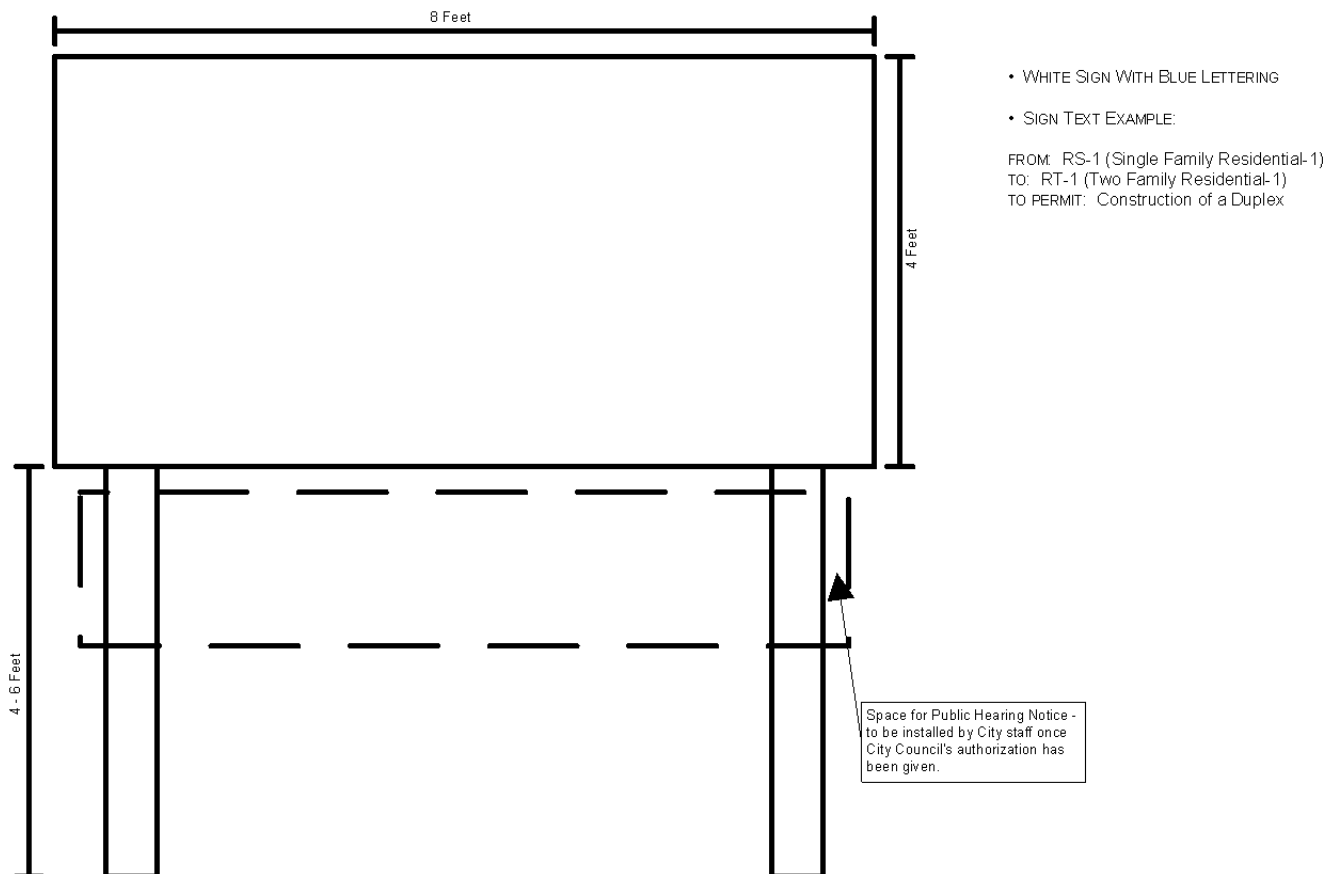

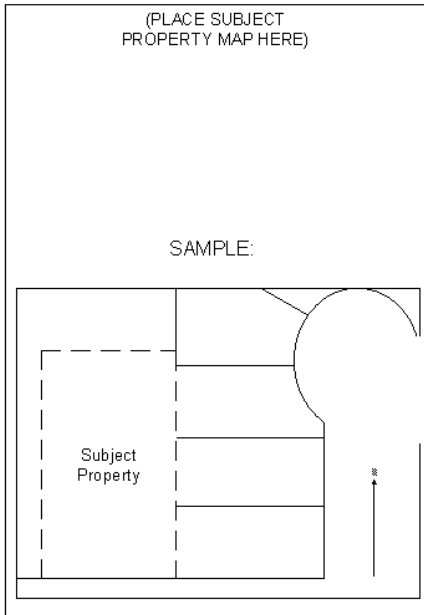
## Rezoning Sign Requirements

- Rezoning applicants are advised that they must post a rezoning sign on the subject property **within ten (10) days** of the date that a completed application is submitted to the Development and Engineering Services Department. The sign shall remain in place until the by-law has been adopted or City Council denies the application. Once the rezoning is completed the sign shall be removed (if not you may be subject to fines).
- Staff will advise you at the front counter whether the statement is suitable for the rezoning sign.
- Signs are to be located on the street frontages with at least one sign per street frontage. On large lots, there shall be a minimum of one sign for every 150 m of street frontage.
- The signs should be placed so that they do not interfere with pedestrian or vehicle traffic or obstruct visibility from streets, lanes, walkways, or driveways.
- The signs must be installed and maintained by the applicant. Signs must remain informative to the public and are to be kept in good condition, capable of withstanding wind and weather.
- **Once the rezoning sign has been erected, the applicant must contact the Development and Engineering Services Department at 250-828-3561 so that staff may inspect the sign.**
