

City of Kamloops Pesticide Use Control By-law No. 26-2



Residents may use Excluded Pesticides (see reverse for list)

Read the **GUARANTEE** on the label

The **GUARANTEE** identifies the common name of the active ingredient. The active ingredient is the part of the product which controls the pest. If the active ingredient is not on the Excluded Pesticide list, it may not be used by residents.

Only approved applicators may apply pesticides that are not on the Excluded list.

Commonly used pesticides that are restricted and only approved applicators may apply:	
Guarantee	Common Use
2, 4-D	Herbicide in weed control products
Dicamba	Herbicide in weed control products
Mecoprop (MCP)	Herbicide in weed control products
Glyphosate	Non-selective herbicide
Carbaryl	Insecticide
Malathion	Insecticide
Permethrin	Insecticide

Pesticide Use Control By-law No. 26-2

The by-law permits the use of certain products for controlling pests on ornamental trees, shrubs, flowers, and turf on residential properties. These products are known as **excluded pesticides** and must be or must contain only the following active ingredients:
