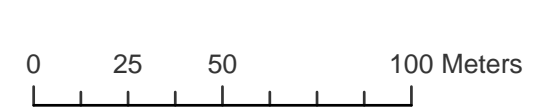


Riverside Park Facility Map

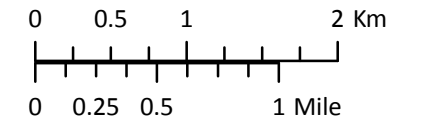


Riverside Park Location Map

About the Park

Located on the banks of the Thompson River next to the Interior Savings Centre, just minutes from downtown. Enjoy a picnic in the picturesque park, stroll along the beach, go for a refreshing swim, bring the kids to the Variety Kids Centennial Water Park, or play a game of lawn bowling. Drop by later in the day for "Music in the Park" which features different bands and musical genres and plays all summer long, each and every evening from 7 - 8:30 pm. Or just soak up the sun and watch the water skiers and wakeboarders do their routines. However you spend your day at Riverside, it is bound to be picture postcard perfect.

How to get there:

- From West: Take Exit 369 Right to Columbia St W, continue straight to City Centre, turn Left at 3rd Ave, continue straight to park entrance
- From East: Exit Right to City Centre, stay Right on Victoria St, stay Right at Lansdowne St, turn Right at 3rd Ave, continue straight to park entrance
- From South: Merge Right onto Hwy 1/5/97, Exit 369 Right to Columbia St W, continue straight to City Centre, turn Left at 3rd Ave, continue straight to park entrance
- From North: Turn Right at Mt Paul Way towards Mt Paul Industrial Park, cross the Red Bridge, turn Right on Lorne St, continue straight to park entrance
