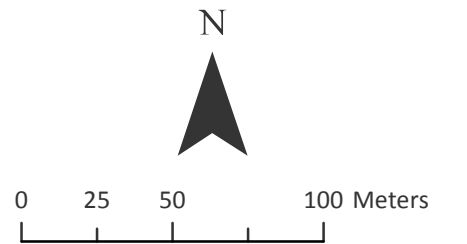


Westsyde Centennial Park Facility Map

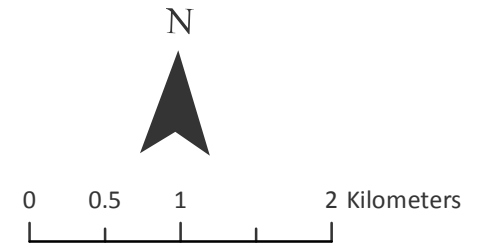

About the Park

Located on the banks of the North Thompson River this park has several amenities for the public to enjoy. Families can enjoy picnics alongside the playground and water park. This park has a soccer field, softball diamond and multi purpose arena. You can also take a stroll or bike ride along the Rivers Trail.

How to get there:

From West: Head east on Halston Ave toward 12 St, use the right lane to take the Westsyde Road ramp merge onto 8th St, use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Westsyde Rd, turn right onto Franklin Rd. The destination will be on the right

From East: Head west on Halston Ave, use the right lane to take the Westsyde Road ramp, merge onto 8th St/Westsyde Rd, use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Westsyde Rd, turn right onto Franklin Rd. The destination will be on the right

From South: Head north on 8th St, use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Westsyde Rd, turn right onto Franklin Rd. The destination will be on the right

From North: Head south on Westsyde Rd toward Ida Ln, turn left onto Franklin Rd. The destination will be on the right
