



ASPEN TREE PLANTING PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

Homeowner Application

The City of Kamloops Community Wildfire Protection and Bark Beetle Management programs will result in a significant reduction in tree cover and visual screening along the boundary of private residential properties and City of Kamloops nature parks and green spaces. To re-establish visual screening, while increasing wildfire protection to these homes, the City will supply Aspen trees to homeowners who have agreed to irrigate these trees. Trembling Aspen trees are a natural species in our local forests where sufficient soil moisture occurs. The 6 to 8 foot trees will be delivered to homeowners for planting on City properties immediately bordering individual private properties, based on home owner desires, infrastructure locations and tree health concerns. Homeowners will be responsible for ongoing irrigation of these trees. All orders must be in by April 30 (Spring planting) or September 30 (Fall). Deliveries are subject to tree availability.

2. Regular watering of the tree(s) will be carried out by the residents of the adjoining property and who have signed this application.
3. Ongoing hazard mitigation will be the responsibility of the City of Kamloops.
