

BC BUILDING/PLUMBING INTERNAL CODE APPEAL APPLICATION

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Internal Code Appeal: Where a resolution to a result related to a plan review or inspection deficiency is not possible with a City Building Official, a formal appeal request can be made by the appellant and is to be submitted to the Building Section under the following requirements:

- A completed <u>City of Kamloops internal code appeal</u> application form. The applicant completes Section 1 on page 2, and the Building Official completes Section 2 on page 2.
- An agency agreement must be provided if the appeal is not made by the owner/agent on record.
- Written details of the dispute with specific reference to the Code section(s) with accompanying intent and objective/functional statements when applicable.
- Sufficient data to support the appeal (e.g. drawings, photos, BC Code appeals/interpretations and reports).

A decision or extension request will be provided within three to five working days from the accepted application date. No works shall continue in the affected area of the dispute unless otherwise confirmed with the Building Official involved with the project.
