Re: Critical Infrastructure Repairs and Road Closures on 3rd Avenue

Starting on Tuesday, March 4, BC Hydro will be undertaking critical infrastructure repairs on 3rd Avenue between Seymour Street and Lansdowne Street. This work is necessary to ensure that we can continue to provide safe and reliable electrical service to our customers in this area.

Construction Timeline

Construction is scheduled to begin on Tuesday, March 4 and will be completed by Monday, March 24, 2025. Crews will be on site seven days a week during regular business hours.

Planned Power Outages

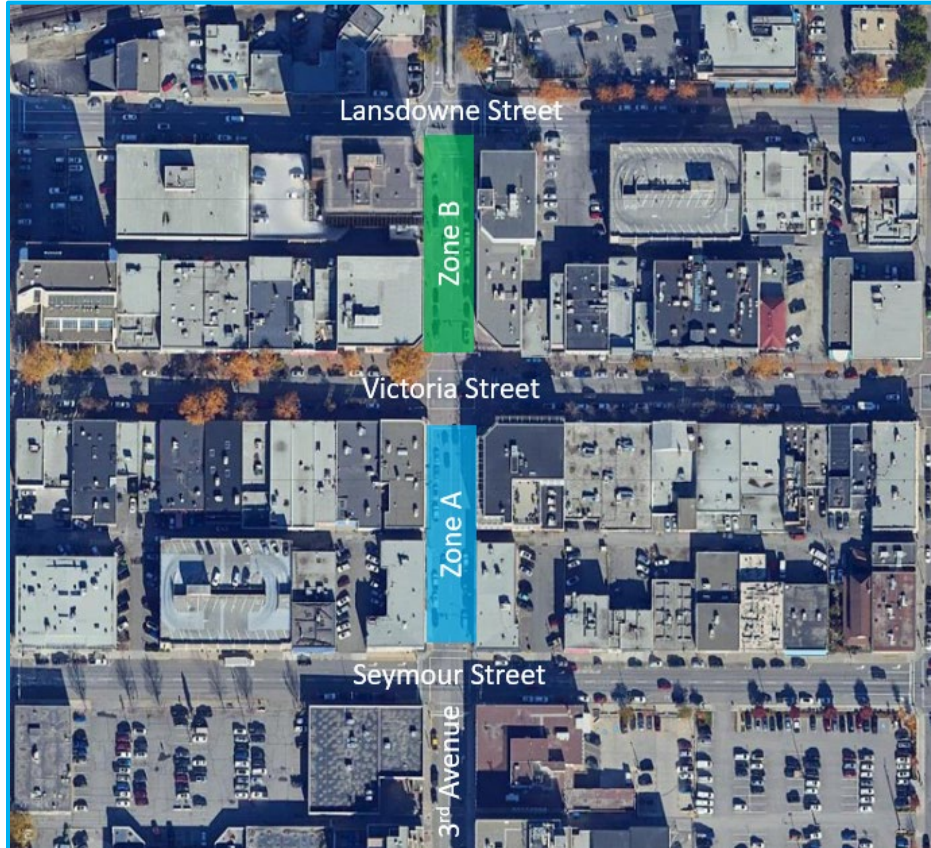
Several planned power outages will be required for our crews to safely complete this work. These outages will be scheduled from midnight to 5 a.m. to minimize any impacts to our customers, and we will notify all impacted customers directly in advance of the outages.

Road Closures

To ensure public and worker safety, 3rd Avenue between Seymour Street and Lansdowne Street (see the map on page 2) will be closed to all motorized vehicles as per the following schedule:
