



ELECTION CAMPAIGN SIGNS

DO



- ✓ Check with the Election team before you place signs if you're not sure.
- ✓ Ask for permission before putting signs on private property.
- ✓ Refer to [Maps.Kamloops.ca/ElectionSigns](https://maps.kamloops.ca/ElectionSigns) for a visual of the prohibited areas set out in [Sign Regulation Bylaw No. 11-77](#).
- ✓ Refer to the [BC Government Election Signs Policy](#) to find out about election signs on highway rights-of-way.
- ✓ Ensure all your election signs are removed no later than seven days following general voting day.

DON'T



- ✗ Put signs in City parks or medians.
- ✗ Put signs on areas with mowed lawn, flowers, or irrigation.
- ✗ Put signs within 100 m of a polling location on the four voting days: October 7, 10, 14, and 17.
- ✗ Put signs that will visually obstruct, simulate, or detract from any traffic control signs.
- ✗ Attach or affix signs to vegetation, municipal structures, or property or newspaper boxes.
