

WHAT IS HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)?



CORROSIVE

Corrosive wastes are acids or bases that are capable of corroding metal containers.



FLAMMABLE

Flammable wastes can create fires under certain conditions and are spontaneously combustible.



COMPRESSED GAS

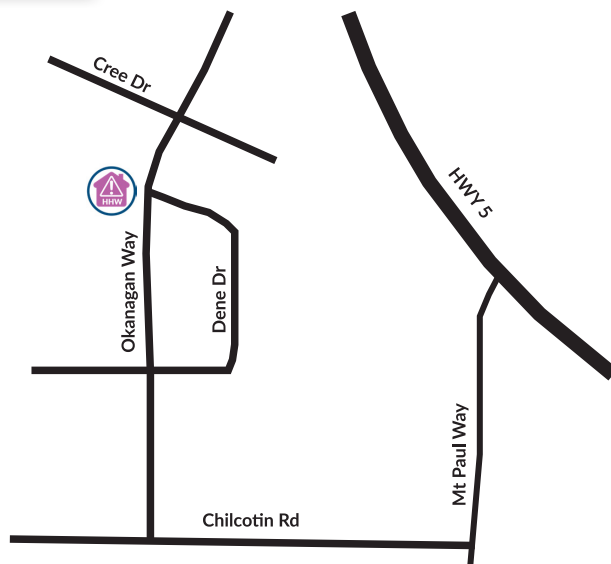
Compressed gases such as aerosol containers or reactive wastes can cause explosions, toxic fumes, gases or vapours when heated, compressed or mixed with water.



POISONOUS

Poison or toxic wastes such as cleaning fluids, pesticides and medicines can be poisonous or lethal, even in small quantities, to adults, children and pets.

AEROSOL CANS (NON-PAINT)

- Bear spray
- Bug repellent
- Cleaners
- Crack filler
- Fertilizers (liquid or solid)
- Insecticides
- Pesticides (liquid or solid)

AUTOMOTIVE PRODUCTS

- Cleaners, polishes, paints, fillers
- Used oil, oil filters, and antifreeze

BATTERIES

- Automotive Lead-Acid
- Household Batteries

CORROSIVES

- All purpose cleaners
- Bleach, ammonia
- Degreasers
- Grout cleaners
- Household cleaners
- Metal cleaners
- Semi solid floor wax

FLAMMABLES

- Acetone
- Camp fuel
- Contains flammable symbol or "keep away from open flame"
- Degreasers
- Flammable solids (Eg. Roof patch, carpet and tile adhesive)
- Furniture stripper
- Methanol
- Mineral spirits
- Paint stripper
- Sealants, caulking
- Turpentine, varsol, other solvents

FUEL

- Gasoline/Diesel (Must be in an approved ulc container (Jerry can). Container will not be returned to customer. Limited to containers 25 litres in size or smaller)
- Gas/Oil Mixtures
- Propane (canisters and cylinders)

MERCURY THERMOSTATS

PAINT

- Aerosol spray paint
- Automotive paint Interior, exterior latex, oil paints and primers Varnish, urethane
- Concrete, stucco and masonry paint
- Marine paint
- Industrial paint, epoxy, craft paint
- Unlabelled paint, rusted cans

OXIDIZERS

- Hot tub and pool chemicals

* Commercial hazardous waste disposal may be limited and fees will apply. This includes Asbestos Containing Products and Lead-Painted Products. If you require more information, contact the TNRD at: 250-377-2596, or recycleright@tnrd.ca



To determine if a product is hazardous, look for the words "Caution," "Warning," or "Danger" on the labels. A hazardous product can be toxic, flammable, corrosive, or reactive.



Mandatory declaration form required for free drop off

Loads without a declaration form will be charged for on a per item basis.



- ✗ Agricultural Pesticides
- ✗ Ammunition, Flares, Explosives
- ✗ Asbestos
- ✗ Biomedical Waste
- ✗ Commercial Hazardous Waste (fees may apply)
- ✗ Cooking oil
- ✗ Leaking or Improperly Sealed Products
- ✗ Pharmaceuticals
- ✗ Radioactive Waste and Sharps



IMPORTANT SAFETY TIPS

- Keep products in original containers or in tightly secured containers
- Do not mix chemicals
- Pack items in a sturdy box upright in your trunk
- Do not pack materials in large plastic bags
- Tape lithium and button-cell batteries
- Empty and dry chemical containers may be recycled or into your regular garbage
