LOCAL AREA SERVICE ON COUNCIL INITIATIVE – SUBJECT TO PETITION AGAINST
TO RE-ESTABLISH THE KAMLOOPS CENTRAL BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA

The undersigned owner(s) of the parcels that would be subject to a local service tax associated with the re-establishment of the Kamloops Central Business Improvement Area to conduct business promotion programs hereby petition Kamloops City Council **not** to proceed with the re-establishment of the Kamloops Central Business Improvement Area, as shown boldly outlined on the map on the reverse of this form.

Re-establishment of the Kamloops Central Business Improvement Area will require an annual local service tax imposed on all parcels prescribed as Class 5 and Class 6 under the *Assessment Act* located within the business improvement area based on assessed value for general municipal purposes for five years commencing in 2027. The local service tax would be included on parcel owners' annual property tax statements. Any change in assessed values would vary the amount of the local service tax. The maximum total amount to be collected and distributed during the five-year period will not exceed \$3,042,987.05, and the associated annual amounts will not exceed:

Council may proceed with the re-establishment of the Kamloops Central Business Improvement Area **unless** it receives petitions in this form from the owners of at least 50% of the parcels **and** representing at least 50% of the assessed value of land and improvements that would be subject to the local service tax.

Please note that in accordance with the *Community Charter*, two or more owners of a parcel must be considered as one owner only. If two or more persons are owners of a parcel, they are not entitled to petition unless a majority of them concurs, and unless a petition is signed by a majority of them, their signatures must be disregarded in determining whether the petition is sufficient.

A person who would be liable for a local service tax by reason of being the holder or occupier of land held in the manner referred to in Part 7, Division 8 [*Tax Liability of Occupiers*] of the *Community Charter* may sign the petition as if the person were the owner. Only official petition forms will be accepted.

A person may not withdraw their name from the petition after 4:00 pm on September 11, 2026.
