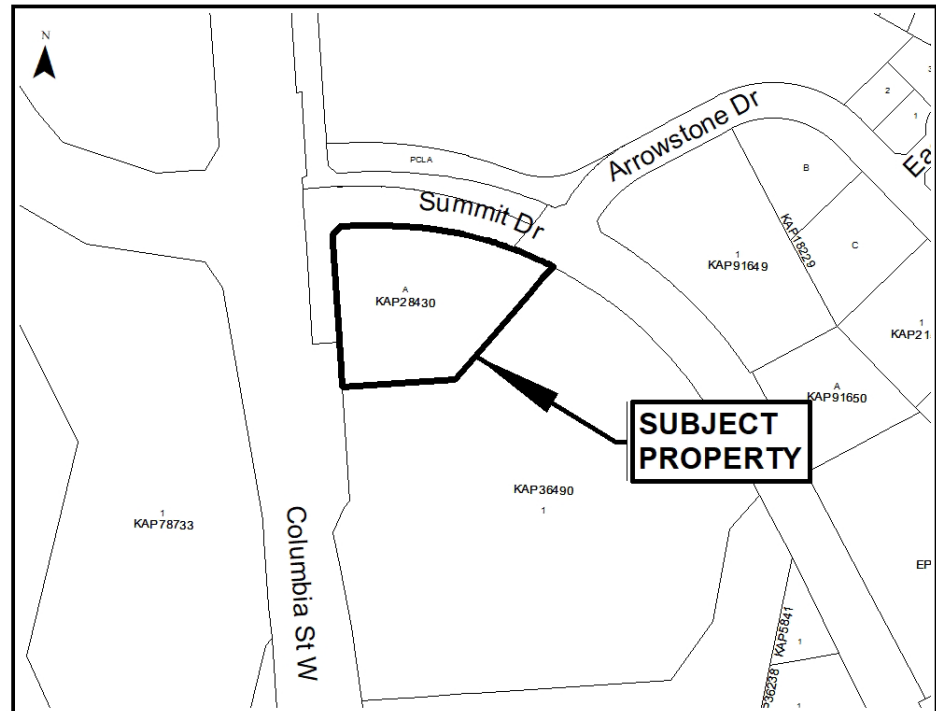
**When?** Tuesday, March 29, 2022, 1:30 pm, at the Regular Council Meeting  
**Where?** Council Chambers, City Hall, 7 Victoria Street West  
**Why?** Kamloops City Council will be considering a resolution to issue a development variance permit.

**Property Location:** 

1200 Summit Drive

**Purpose:**

To reduce the minimum two-way parking aisle width from 7.3 m to 6.0 m, and to vary Sign Regulations Bylaw No. 11-77 by increasing the maximum free-standing sign height from 6 m to 7 m and the maximum free-standing sign area from 6 m<sup>2</sup> to 10.4 m<sup>2</sup> to permit a free-standing, multi-tenant sign.
