- Completion of a recognized group fitness certification is considered an asset

Nature and Scope of Work

This term employment position will work on an hourly basis based on class availability for the Spring/Summer term (April-August 2019). The successful incumbent will perform skilled work under the direct supervision of the Healthy Living and Wellness Coordinator. This work will include delivery of safe and appropriate Aquafit classes to a variety of ability levels at the Westsyde Pool & Fitness Centre, Tournament Capital Centre or other City of Kamloops Facilities. The successful incumbent will possess excellent communication skills and be confident working in an unsupervised environment, and as part of a team.
