

FOOD TRUCK OR TRAILER REGULATIONS MATRIX

Definition: "FOOD TRUCK OR TRAILER" means a food truck or mobile trailer from which food and/or drink is prepared internally and dispensed externally, which is parked at a given private property location for no more than five days in any one week or in parks or on-street locations where permitted by the City.
