Brock and Valleyview Arenas have ramps to allow patrons in wheelchairs to access and use the ice during public skating sessions! Helmets are mandatory for the person using the wheelchair, and any attendants must wear a helmet and skates.

Canada's Tournament Capital

The City of Kamloops recommends using CSA-certified helmets.

Public Ice Skating - Recreational ice skating for all ages. Children ages seven and under must be accompanied on the ice by an adult wearing skates. Children ages 12 and under are required to wear a helmet; helmets are strongly recommended for youth and adults. No sticks or pucks are permitted.

Stick & Puck (13+) - For players 13 years and older. All participants are required to wear a helmet and gloves. Bring your own stick and puck. No goalies, slap shots, or scrimmages are permitted. The program is monitored by Skate Patrol. Maximum of 30 participants.

Family Stick & Puck - For children ages 12 and under to play with their adult guardians. All participants are required to wear a helmet and gloves. Children must be accompanied on the ice by an adult. Please bring your own stick and puck. No goalies, slap shots, or scrimmages are permitted. The program is monitored by Skate Patrol. Maximum of 30 participants.

Beginner Adult Drop-in Hockey (18+) - This program is geared towards players with a novice or beginner skill level. It is a self-organized, non-contact program, and full gear and helmets are mandatory. The program is **not** monitored by Skate Patrol. Players are expected to officiate themselves. Maximum of 30 participants. A waiver must be signed prior to entering the program.

Adult Drop-in Hockey (18+) - Self-organized, non-contact program; full gear and helmets are mandatory. The program is **not** monitored by Skate Patrol. Players are expected to officiate themselves. Maximum of 30 participants. A waiver must be signed prior to entering the program.

FREE - Value Added Programs ★

★ **Preschool Skating** - Recreational ice skating for children ages 6 and under. The parent/caregiver is required to accompany and supervise the child on the ice and wear skates. Helmets are mandatory for children and strongly recommended for the parent/caregiver. Skate at your own risk. The program is **not** monitored by Skate Patrol.

★ **Family Skating** - Recreational ice skating for families only (children ages 12 and under). Helmets are required for children and strongly recommended for adults. No sticks or pucks. The parent/guardian must accompany child(ren) on the ice and wear skates. The program is **not** monitored by Skate Patrol.

★ **Adult Only (19+)** - Recreational ice skating for adults only. Skate at your own risk. This program is **not** monitored by Skate Patrol. No sticks or pucks; helmets are strongly recommended.

★ **Seniors Only (55+)** - Recreational ice skating for seniors only. Skate at your own risk. This program is **not** monitored by Skate Patrol. No sticks or pucks; helmets are strongly recommended.
