
Overview

Changes:

Did <u>not</u> change:

- Community vision and values
- Population/housing projections
- Land uses and densities
- Overall direction of OCP policies







New Policies | Added to...

- Support transit use and enhanced pedestrian connectivity in the North Shore Town Centre and Tranquille Market Corridor
- Increase public awareness and education of environmentally sensitive areas
- Encourage energy efficiency and reduce GHGs in the design and retrofitting of commercial and residential buildings
- Encourage retrofitting of existing buildings to include electric vehicle charging infrastructure
- Explore the potential for residential on-street parking permits to be considered towards off-street parking requirements





Refined Policies | Revised to...

- Reduce the walkable radius for neighbourhood centres from 800 m to 400 m
- Consider limited client or customer access to home-based businesses
- Permit manufactured homes for farm help and family members on active farms
- Clarify permitted location of drive-thrus and other auto-oriented businesses
- Clarify that a Thompson River bridge crossing will be identified during term of OCP





Refined Policies | Revised to...

- Clarify where secondary, garden, and carriage suites are encouraged and discouraged
- Require adaptable design of new ground-level, single-storey multifamily units
- Strengthen language of Archaeology Resource Management goal
- Expand food security policy to include focus on increasing local food access






Future (Industrial) Development Areas
