What is ARCH?

The City of Kamloops wants to support your active lifestyle!

Recreation is important for healthy living, and the City wants everyone in our community to reach their goals.

ARCH is a program that helps you access City facilities and programs.

Do I Qualify?

To qualify for ARCH, you must be a permanent resident in the City of Kamloops and meet **ONE** of the options below:

- a) receive income assistance from the Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction
- b) have an annual income that falls below the Statistics Canada Low Income Guidelines**
- c) receive a Canadian pension or long-term disability that falls below the Statistics Canada Low Income Guidelines**

How Do I Apply?

Step 1:

Visit us at www.kamloops.ca/arch or call 250-828-3582 to see if you qualify.

Step 2:

Fill out an **application form**.

The **application form** is available at www.kamloops.ca/arch or can be picked up at the following locations:

- Westsyde Pool
- Kamloops Museum & Archives
- any ARCH Agency

Step 3:

Take your application to a **Public Screening Agency** (see next page or go to www.kamloops.ca/arch for the **ARCH Agency List**).

Step 4:

If you are approved, you will be given an **Approval Letter** and information package.

Step 5:

Bring your **Approval Letter** and picture ID to TCC, Westsyde Pool, or Kamloops Museum & Archives to be registered in the ARCH program.
