**Why?** Kamloops City Council will hold a Public Hearing to consider the following proposed amendment to City of Kamloops Zoning Bylaw No. 55.

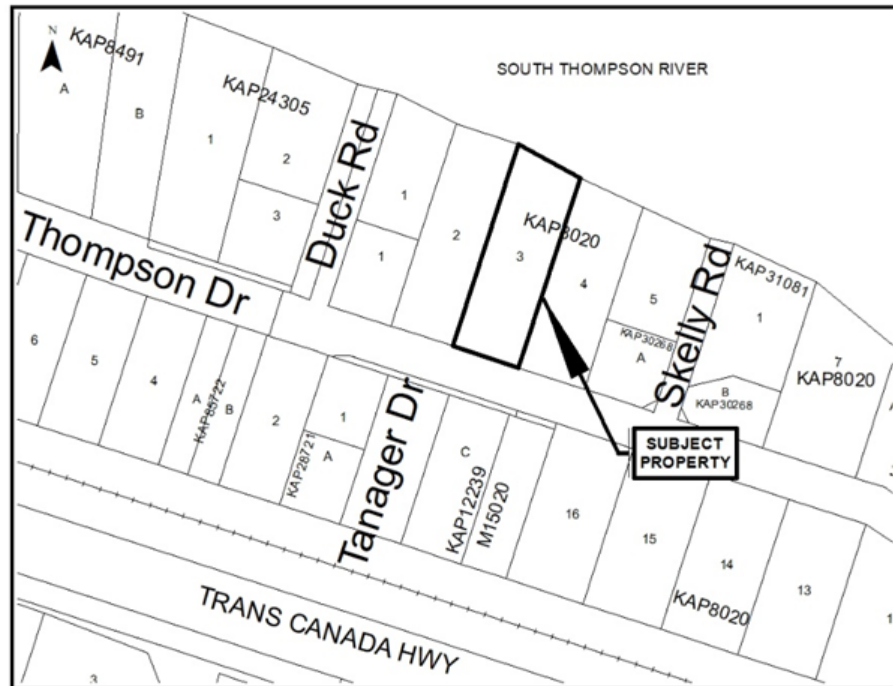
**Property Location:**
